When: Conducted daily. Please contact our office for available times.

Where: Our Training Complex is at 39 Jackson Street, Glenorchy. Parking is opposite at 24 Jackson Street. Metro Bus Service stops nearby and is accessible from the Glenorchy Bus interchange.

Costs: Please see above for cost structure. For courses a deposit of \$250.00 is required to confirm your booking; for tests payment in full is required. An account may be provided by prior arrangement. Account bookings require a purchase order and signed Course Booking Agreement (available from our office or website) to confirm the booking.

Funding is available for eligible job seekers, which may cover 100% of the course cost. Please contact your employment agency for details. Purchase orders need to be received by OnRoad OffRoad ten business days prior to the agreed date of training.

Requirements: We require applicants to meet the following:

For LR: 19+ yrs, held a car licence for 12 months.

For MR: 19+ yrs, held car licence for 12 months.

For HR: 20+ yrs, held car licence for 2 years or LR/MR licence for 12 months.

For HC: 20+ yrs, held car licence for 2 years or MR/HR licence for 12 months.

For MC: 21+ yrs, held HR/HC licence for 12 months.

Course Structure:

Courses consist of theory, practical demonstration, practical training and assessment and a licence test.

Applicants that identify as having language, literacy or numeracy difficulties should notify the office at the time of booking so arrangements can be made for assistance.

Each course is limited to a maximum of 1 trainee.

Appropriate clothing and sandshoes or boots (no open-toed footwear) is required. All safety equipment is provided by OnRoad OffRoad Training.

Heavy Vehicle Driver Licences

Upon successful completion of the licence test or approved course, paperwork will be given to the applicant to take to any Service Tasmania outlet for lodgement. If the applicant has not completed their Driver Knowledge Test, they will need to do so at this time.

Driver Knowledge Tests

In addition to the written/oral theory test conducted during the training, it is required that applicants complete the Driver Knowledge Test at Service Tasmania. This can be done prior to the scheduled course dates or alternatively when they have successfully completed a DIER approved licence test and received the appropriate paperwork from the assessor. Information and support is provided in preparation for this test.
