**When:** All courses and assessments are subject to availability and schedule. Please indicate to our staff if you have date preferences or restrictions.

**Where:** Our Training Complex is at 39 Jackson Street, Glenorchy. Parking is opposite at 24 Jackson Street. Metro Bus Service stops nearby and is accessible from the Glenorchy Bus interchange.

**Requirements:** We require most applicants to be over the age of 19 years, and have held a full car licence for 12 months. Appropriate clothing and sandals or boots (no open-toed footwear). All safety and training equipment is provided by OnRoad OffRoad. Applicants must also bring current photo-ID (driver's licence or student card).

Refreshments are provided for morning and afternoon tea. A break is provided for lunch during each day of training. There are many take-away stores nearby, although trainees can bring lunch with them if desired.

Workbooks are provided to assist trainees throughout the courses. They are used, together with, instructions from the trainer to ensure that each applicant has a thorough understanding of the material demonstrated. The courses are designed for a broad range of applicants, including those who have regularly driven or operated the equipment and those that have not.
