PURPOSE:

This course provides building and construction industry workers with the introductory understanding and knowledge needed to commence or continue work in the building and construction industry.

- Basic concepts of workplace health and safety plans and work method statements
- Physical building and construction hazards
- Basic risk management concepts including hazard identification, assessment of risk, control of risk and evaluation of control measures
- The hierarchy of controls (eliminate, substitute, redesign, isolate, administrate and use of personal protective equipment (PPE))
- Emergency procedures.
